AUCKLAND - PAIHIA (APPROX. 03 HRS)

After breakfast check out from Auckland hotel. Proceed to Paihia. Standard check in 14:00 hrs. Check in hotel. Later Proceed to Lunch. After check in rest day is for optional adventure activity like paragliding, skydiving, cycling The seething power of inner earth comes to the surface in Rotorua. Explore Rotorua's geothermal areas and discover the unique culture of New Zealand's Maori people. Rotorua offers a great selection of mountain biking and cycling attractions and activities. Enjoy the great outdoors and superb New Zealand scenery on a mountain bike trail or cycling track around Rotorua. Dinner at Indian Restaurant.









After breakfast proceed to Paihia and visit Fuller Great Sights Paihia, Cape Brett Hole in the Rock Cruise.

Cruise through the sheltered waters of the Bay of Islands on Dolphin Seeker, our purpose built dolphin and whale watching catamaran. Enjoy the large outdoor viewing decks as we cruise past the islands of the Bay. Keep a look out for common and bottlenose dolphins, whales and other marine life as we get you up close to the action from the comfort of Dolphin Seeker. Our catamaran is licensed by DOC (the Department of Conservation) for dolphin viewing. Enjoy the views as you cruise past the Cape Brett Lighthouse, before arriving at the majestic Hole in the Rock – hold your breath as the skipper navigates through the narrow space and admire the rock walls which soar above you. AUCKLAND - WAITOMO CAVES(APPROX 02 HRS 30 MIN) - ROTORUA(02 HRS)

After breakfast check out from Auckland hotel & Proceed to Rotorua Via Waitomo Caves Tour The acoustics in this particular cavern are worldrenowned. Acclaimed New Zealand Diva, Dame Kiri Te Kanawa, has sung here and was delighted with the purity of the sound. Rainbow Springs is a stunning kiwi wildlife park where you can get up close and personal with all of NZ's favourite native birds and lizards, including the kiwi and tuatara. Evening is enjoy half hours Polynesian Spa in Rotorua –Polynesian Spa is a developed geothermal spa facility in Rotorua, North Island, New Zealand. Return back to Queenstown. Dinner at Indian Restaurant.










MOUNT COOK / TWIZEL
